Requirements of Program

- Minimum B average and fulfillment of service requirements
- Students must complete at least one Advanced Placement class in each of the following content areas:
 - Science (Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics B)
 - Math (Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics)
 - English (English Language, English Literature)
 - Social Studies (US History, Psychology, U Government)

What is an AP Course?

- AP Stands for Advanced Placement.
- The AP Program is regulated nationally by The College Board.
- AP courses help prepare students to take a national exam in the particular content area. If the student scores well (usually 3 or higher on a 5 point scale) on this exam, he/she can earn college credits while in high school.
- Fitchburg High School is endorsed to offer 14 AP courses for the 2013-2014 school year.

Components of Program

- Capstone service based project during senior year;
- Special designation on the transcript;
 - *Student completed the rigorous requirements of the FHS Honors Academy*
