# **Team Leader Responsibilities**

### Advisor

Serve on the building level Teaching and Learning Council through participation in monthly two-hour meetings with the Building Principal to provide shared-leadership in the areas of:

Examining data relevant to student learning and other student issues

Providing direction for weekly team meetings

Developing budgetary requests based on needs related to building and district improvement

Consulting on professional development for staff that will improve student learning Reviewing and developing processes and criteria for the selection/revision of curriculum/courses/materials/assessment tools

Recommending new programs or policies

Serve on the district level Teaching and Learning Council through participation in five two-hour district level meetings (October, November, January, March, and May) annually with the Superintendent, Director of Learning and Teaching and Principals to provide shared-leadership in these areas:

Developing district initiatives to improve student achievement

Recommending district Professional Development

Providing oversight of the Comprehensive Teacher Induction Program

Reviewing district student data

Providing oversight of curriculum review/coordination processes

## **Facilitator**

Lead all Team Meetings (Professional Learning Communities)

Assist in the development of school initiatives

### Liaison
